



Experienced teachers will explain questions in class, and students will have a chance to review questions at home for a limited time. A detailed student performance report will also be provided.


*In-line with current NAPLAN testing conditions, Year 3 students will complete writing exams on paper. Year 5, 7 and 9 students will complete the writing component online.






